5. Eligibility and rules of origin

Tender Participation is open on equal terms as divided and described per to commercial companies and non-governmental organizations, international and national, which are registered to perform demilitarization of ammunition activities and possess license to perform demilitarization of ammunition activities issued by relevant national bodies, valid for the time of the planned start and finish of the works, and are eligible to participate on Tender, reference No.: ITF-01/13-CWD-CRO-USA.

6. Tender validity and tender guarantee

Tenders shall remain valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days after the deadline for submission of Tenders and must be accompanied by a Tender guarantee. Value of the Tender guarantees is 5.000,00 USD. The Tender guarantee shall be valid for a period up to and including minimum 90 (ninety) days after the deadline for submission of Tender. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful Tenderer(s) once the tender procedure has been completed and to the successful Tenderer(s) upon signature of the contract by all parties.

7. Performance guarantees

The successful Tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 10 % of the contract amount for the period of 180 days after signing of the contract. If the selected Tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the Tenderer, which has submitted the second best admissible Tender.

8. How to obtain the tender dossier

Interested eligible Tenderer(s) may purchase the Tender documents for the projects at the ITF office, Zabrva 12, Ig, from **Thursday, 04 April 2013** from 12:00 hours, and in following days. Tenders must be submitted using standard Tender form included in the Tender dossier, of which format and instructions must be strictly observed.

9. Deadline for submission of tenders

The sealed Tenders shall be delivered by registered mail or in person, to **ITF Enhancing Human Security, Zabrva 12, 1292 Ig, Slovenia/EU** by **Monday 6 May 2013** at 11:30 (local time). Any tender received after this deadline will not be considered.

10. Deadline for completion of works

All works on the projects under this Tender must be completed the latest by **30 November 2013**.
